Introduction

This Report aims at enhancing the Parliament performance through performance indicators of members of parliaments (MPs) according to the local point of view in order to strengthen the ties with the voters. The Report shall inform all stakeholders, such as voters, civil society organizations, and MPs, of the standards of legislation to examine the suitability of the government's decisions and legislations to the citizens' needs and aspirations, thus, closing the gap between decision makers and citizens, and strengthening the relationship of all parties in order to improve the parliamentary work so that it meets the aspirations of the electoral bases.

The Report informs electoral bases of the performance of the MPs and enables them to use the information and findings of the Report as an observation tool to question MPs which enhances responsibility and accountability and raises awareness of these principles. The Report also serves to help future voters better choose their representatives and improve standards of such a choice.

The indicators and findings can help MPs improve their performance through more communication with the electoral bases to reflect their aspirations and needs in relation to monitoring and legislation.

The need to build effective relations with the electoral bases is considered one of the important tasks MPs should carry out for the constituents' priorities, MPs and the government. MPs are the direct links between the citizens and their government as they get involved in local issues, build legislative solutions, and bring a broad scope of citizen's participation for local decision making which help enhance effective and positive electoral bases participation.

The Report is a reflection of the national responsibility taken by We Participate as a civil society organization to support the reform process in Jordan. The Report also introduces findings that can help build best practices to enhance parliamentary work which positively affects the service of the electoral bases with relation to monitoring and legislation.

Report Preparation Methodology

We Participate Team adopted a clear methodology targeting a chosen sample of the electoral bases. The sample includes members of local/civil society organizations, representatives of political parties, members of local municipalities, members of decentralization councils, members of executive councils, government sector employees, academics, members of the Bar Association, the Engineers Association, Teachers' Syndicate and Doctors' Syndicate, youth activists, women activists, university students, university graduates, employed and unemployed persons, owners of private companies, and retirees from the public and private sectors. Researchers used preprepared questionnaires that are based on global monitoring indicators on which they were trained. The questionnaires were directly conducted on responders by researchers.

The Report adopted some indicators to follow-up with MPs performance outside the Parliament and examine if they act in the interests of their constituents. These indicators were based on best practices of monitoring parliamentary performance at the local level. The following are the most important indicators used in the Report to monitor MPs performance at the local level:

- The extent MPs communicate with their constituents
- Whether constituents are involved in the legislative and oversight decision-making processes and also in the discussion's MPs have in the Parliament about laws
- If citizens can reach MPs easily
- Whether MPs form community committees or offices in their electoral districts
- If MPs hold regular meetings with their constituencies and use different social media platforms to communicate with them.

We Participate Center for Civil Society Development

We Participate is a Jordanian non-profit non-governmental civil society center, established in 2014 by young Jordanian activists in Zarqa city. The Center aims at enforcing accountability and public participation in decision making in Jordan based on democracy and human rights principles. It works also to raise awareness of civil values, such as freedom, equality, justice, and best participation, as well as strengthening social cohesion among Jordanians.

The Center believes that youth and women are the core of social development and that effective participation is the basis of change for a democratic and supportive society. The Center carries out activities that target both youth and women to make sure that they play active roles, designing strategies and developing plans for the center, through discussion sessions addressing societal challenges and their solutions and plans to overcome them.

We Participate has established a network with the civil society organizations by forming a coalition "Musharakah" which consists of 34 local CBOs from different regions of Jordan, including rural and remote areas, Badia, and refugee camps. The aim is to ensure comprehensive participation of local communities across various geographical distributions and economic levels.

Project of Empowering Jordanian CBOs to Enhance Local Parliamentary Accountability

The Project of Empowering Jordanian CBOs to Enhance Local Parliamentary Accountability established by We Participate Center is a leading project at the national and Arab levels. This Project believes in the importance of increasing the participation of local communities in public decision-making by enhancing concepts of societal and institutional accountability and oversight as a consistent approach that contributes to enhancing parliamentary performance, and closing the gap between parliamentarians and electoral bases in order to serve the political reform process in Jordan.

The Project is implemented by We Participate Center with the cooperation of the Community Coalition for Monitoring MPs Performance (Musharaka), which consists of 34 local civil society institutions, and the strategic partnership with AL-Hayat Center-Rased, all under Qararuna Program, funded by the EU and AECID.

The Project of Empowering Jordanian CBOs to Enhance Local Parliamentary Accountability comes as a response to the fourth component of Qararuna's EU-JDID which is "supporting the civil society to contribute to democratic governance and policy making in Jordan", in addition to its basic components of supporting parliaments, elections and political parties.

Community Coalition for Monitoring MPs Performance (Musharakah)

Based on the importance of the national role played by civil society institutions and to achieve public interest, We Participate Center has launched the Community Coalition for Monitoring MPs Performance (Musharakah) in order to enhance community monitoring and to strengthen positive ties between civil society institutions and elected houses. This was also done following what has been mentioned in the Fourth Royal Discussion Paper published by His Majesty King Abdullah II which states that "..one of the key requirements for democratization efforts is enhancing the role of civil society in monitoring and elevating the political performance of all institutions, by enrooting a democratic culture across society that guarantees a tangible bottom-up change."
















Quantitative Results of A Questionnaire about Monitoring the Performance of the Parliament at the Constituency Level

Recommendations for the Report's Findings to Improve Parliamentary Work

Recommendations for Parliamentarians towards their Constituencies

- 1. Establish community committees at the electoral levels to strengthen communication between parliamentarians and their electoral bases;
- 2. Enhance parliamentarians' discussions with their constituencies about legislative and oversight performance in local sessions to exchange points of view;
- 3. Parliaments should publish the addresses of their offices and announce periodic meetings through social media to facilitate communication with the electoral bases;
- 4. Promote transparency of parliamentary performance and publish all the work in the different media platforms;
- 5. Educate the public at local and national levels about the legislative and government oversight role of MPs in order change the stereotype that MPs only provide services to constituents:
- 6. Consider the recommendations and suggestions made by civil society institutions in parliament performance monitoring reports;
- 7. Involve civil society institutions in the discussions held within the Parliament, especially those related to monitoring and oversight of government performance, so that they can participate in decision-making;

Recommendations for Constituencies towards their Representatives

- 1. Support the communications with the MPs by enhancing regular meetings between MPs and their constituents which will increase the political participation of constituents and also promote the principles of participation, transparency, accountability, and local decision-making;
- 2. Elevate the role of constituents from mere voters to active participants in local decision-making by providing project proposals to MPs and follow them up through different communication means available:

Recommendations for Civil Society Institutions towards Parliamentarians

- 1. Civil society institutions should play their role to link decision makers with local communities so that the latter can participate in decision-making.
- 2. Provide policies, researches, and studies that can support the legislative discussions held by MPs in the Parliament;

This report comes as one of the outputs of the project "Empowering Jordanian CBOs to Enhance Local Parliamentary Accountability", which aims to improve parliamentary performance by strengthening community accountability practices, increasing communication between parliaments and electoral bases to reflect the aspirations of voters within parliament and enhancing citizens' participation in parliamentary legislation and parliamentary monitoring.

It also aims to inform the electoral bases about the performance of their representatives who were elected during their time as members of the House of Representatives, and to enable them to use the information and results concluded by the report as a monitoring tool to hold parliaments accountable, which enhances the principles of responsibility, accountability and raises the awareness of these electoral bases with these principles. This report also helps prospective voters develop selection criteria to properly represent them in the future.

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
